WINES, VINES, WOOLIES & WETLANDS: TICKETS ON SALE NOW! 3RD ANNUAL CARNEROS HERITAGE FEST, MAY 31

CARNEROS, CA (April 8, 2008): Tickets are now on sale for the 3rd ANNUAL CARNEROS HERITAGE FEST -- Wines, Vines, Woolies & Wetlands -- on Saturday, May 31 from Noon to 4 pm. Proceeds from the event will benefit the Carneros Land Stewardship Foundation, which is dedicated to the conservation and preservation of habitat in the San Pablo Bay wetlands adjacent to the Carneros region.

What: 3rd Annual Carneros Heritage Fest - Wines, Vines, Woolies & Wetlands

When: Saturday May 31, noon to 4 p.m.

Where: The Donum Estate (24520 Ramal Road in Sonoma) in the Los Carneros American Viticultural Area 40 minutes north of San Francisco, 30 minutes from Marin County, the East Bay and 60 minutes from both the South Bay and Sacramento.

How: All inclusive tickets are \$75 per person, Children under 12 (accompanied by parent) are free. Tickets are available from the Carneros Wine Alliance website, www.carnerosheritagefest.com, or by check from Carneros Wine Alliance, P.O. Box 178, Vineburg, CA 95487.

The keystone of the Fest will be pairings of Carneros Premium and Ultra Premium wines with a Carneros Lamb BBQ, directed by Mark Rasic, Executive Chef, Google Inc., and grilled by members of the Napa County Farm Bureau with lamb supplied by the American Lamb Board.

Environmental and sustainable agriculture exhibits will include a Grower's Pavilion co-sponsored by the Sonoma County Winegrape Commission, vineyard walks and marsh talks, and other activities and exhibitions by the California Department of Fish and Game.

The Carneros Heritage Fest will also feature a Sheep Herding Exhibition by ranchers Sandy Milberg and Jack Mathieson, artisan wool boutiques, and music by the Back Burner Blues Band (comprised of Napa Valley Chefs led by Joey Altman of TV's Bay Café).
